

New electricity rates of charges

This is a notice under clause 21 of the *Electricity Supply (General) Regulation 2001 (NSW)* setting out details of the variations in the rates of charges for electricity supplied under Integral Energy's Standard Form Customer Supply Contract (Standard Supply Contract).

The variations to the rates of charges for electricity supplied under Integral Energy's Standard Supply Contract, as set out below, take effect from 1 July 2004, and apply to new and existing customers of Integral Energy.

This notice does not apply to customers who have an Electricity Negotiated Supply Agreement with Integral Energy.

1. Rates of charges for electricity supplied under Standard Supply Contract (effective 1 July 2004)

The rates of charges Integral Energy levies for electricity supplied under the Standard Supply Contract (and set out in our Energy Price Guide) have been varied.

An Inclining Block Tariff, or step rate, is being introduced whereby consumption of electricity by customers supplied under the Domestic tariff of over 1,750 kilowatt-hours and consumption of electricity by customers supplied under the General Supply tariff of over 5,250 kilowatt-hours (averaged per quarterly billing period) will be charged at a higher rate.

Our Energy Price Guide has been amended to reflect the variations to rates of charges. The new rates of charges are listed below.

2. Goods and Services Tax (GST)

All rates and charges in this notice are shown exclusive and inclusive of GST. Rates and charges appearing on your bill will be GST exclusive and GST will be shown as a separate line item on your account.

3. Peak Shoulder and Off-Peak Periods

For all Domestic time of use and General Supply time of use tariffs the following definitions apply for Peak, Shoulder and Off-peak periods from 1 July 2004:
