The rating system is already, in my opinion not correct. It is based on the value of the land which in the past years has gone up dramatically and the Council is already charges more each year based on the land value. Then there is a yearly percentage rise which is greater than the CPI. The Council is already increasing its revenue dramatically and should not ask for more.

At the Council meeting when the rise was approved there were hundreds of people who attended and objected however

it fell on deaf ears. They also received many objections in the mail and were ignored.

With property values in the area being around \$500,000 - \$1,000,000 plus, the residents and business owners are already

paying more than their fair share. A rise of 7.5% to 9.3% every year on top of the normal CPI rises and land value rises will

cause extreme hardship for residents and commercial properties who already pay much more than the residential

properties.
