Purpose of the special variation:

Part A - 1.8% for rate peg will be used to part fund the broad range of works and services Council provides on a recurrent basis.

Part B – 1.8% will be used to part fund the implementation of Council's adopted Biodiversity Management Strategy. The Biodiversity Management Strategy is a guiding document that details a range of management activities and incentives used to manage Lismore's high-value biodiversity while ensuring the preservation of productive agricultural land.
