Submission: Dear IPART, As a ratepayer in Coffs Harbour I would like you to reject Councils SRV for the following reasons.

1. Three surveys have shown a great majority over 70% of ratepayers are strongly opposed to council increasing rates over and above cpi. 2. Ratepayers have clearly told council via these surveys that they want Council to reduce their expenses and extracurricular activities, rather than asking ratepayers to pay higher rates.
