



## **LIVERPOOL PLAINS SHIRE COUNCIL (LPSC) CURRENT RESOURCE SHARING ARRANGEMENTS**

1. Central Northern Libraries – also Tamworth Regional Council, Narrabri, Uralla, Gwydir and Walcha Shires.
2. Liverpool Ranges Rural Fire Service – also Upper Hunter and Gunnedah Shires.
3. Northern Inland Regional Waste Group – all Councils in proposed Namoi and New England Joint Regional Organisations.
4. Northern Inland Weeds Advisory Committee – noxious weeds management– member along with all Councils in proposed Namoi and New England Joint Regional Organisations.
5. NAMOI Joint Regional Organisation – Regional advocacy and planning – member also includes Tamworth Regional Council, Gunnedah, Moree Plains, Gwydir, Narrabri and Walcha Shires.
6. Mid North Weight of Loads Group – checking loads on trucks to reduce wear and tear on roads from overloading – member also Armidale, Bellingen, Coffs Harbour, Dungog, Gloucester, Great Lakes, Greater Taree, Kempsey, Muswellbrook, Nambucca, Port Macquarie, Tamworth, Upper Hunter, Uralla and Walcha Councils.
7. New England North West Tourism, a regional tourism body including other member Council's Inverell, Glen Innes Severn, Walcha, Armidale Dumaresq, Gwydir, Narrabri, Tenterfield, Uralla, Guyra and Gunnedah
8. Tourism Tamworth – Tamworth Touring Guide.
9. Kamilaroi Highway Group promoting tourism along the Kamilaroi Highway also includes Gunnedah, Narrabri, Bourke, Brewarrina and Walgett Shire Council's.

10. Statewide Insurance – Regional risk Group WH&S with Moree, Gwydir, Inverell, Glen Innes-Severn, Tenterfield, Guyra, Armidale Dumaresq, Walcha, Tamworth, Gunnedah, Narrabri Shire Council's.
11. Blacktown Sister City – staff exchanges between councils.
12. Gunnedah Shire Council/LPSC – Development Application referrals between councils.
13. Liverpool Plains LEMS (Local Emergency Management) - member working with various emergency organisations to prepare for disasters, etc.
14. HACC Community Transport Services – operated by Gunnedah Oxley Community Options (GOCO) – also includes Gunnedah and Narrabri Councils.
15. LG NSW - Procurement/tenders on behalf of LPSC.
16. Hunter Valley Councils Inc – record storage facility utilized by LPSC.
17. Arts North West – member - also includes Armidale, Glen Innes, Gunnedah, Guyra, Gwydir, Moree, Narrabri, Tamworth, Tenterfield, Uralla and Walcha Councils.
18. Civica User Group member – member - 70 councils Australia wide developing financial and other packages specific to Local Government.
19. RMS - Agency services provided by Council in Quirindi.
20. ARM Inc- member - volunteers managing the Australian Railway Museum at Werris Creek on behalf of Council.
21. Association of Mining Related Councils - Member along with 22 other councils across NSW - organisation advocates on behalf of councils on mining related issues.
22. Northern Regional Food Surveillance Group includes Armidale, Glen Innes, Gunnedah, Guyra, Gwydir, Moree, Narrabri, Tamworth, Tenterfield, Uralla and Walcha Councils.

23. MOU Jockey Club – racecourse and showground maintenance.
24. MOU First Fleet Memorial Gardens - maintenance agreement with volunteers.
25. MOU Lions Club – maintenance of amenities and parks in Werris Creek by Lions Club Members at a fee.
26. MOU Werris Creek cemetery – maintenance agreement with volunteers to look after lawn cemetery.
27. Namoi Water Alliance – member along with Tamworth, Gunnedah, Narrabri and Walcha Councils to share resources and staff with regard to water and sewer operations.
28. Minerals and Energy Working Group – networking and information sharing in relation to mining and resource development in the Namoi Region - member along with regional mining companies, State Government agencies and Tamworth, Gunnedah, Narrabri, Walcha and Uralla Councils.
29. Tr@ceR Electronic Data Management System – LPSC developed, owns and maintains software used by other councils including Brewarrina, Junee, Yass Valley, Gloucester and Liverpool Plains Shire Council's.
30. Tr@ceR Mapping- LPSC has developed a Mobile Mapping program for the mapping of noxious weeds and the program is used by Bega Valley, Tumut, Cooma, Bombala, Narromine, Dubbo, Gunnedah, Narrabri, Moree, Inverell, Glen Innes Severn, Tenterfield, New England Weeds Authority (four LGA's), North West Local Land Services.
31. Quirindi Aero Club – agreement for volunteers to maintain the airport terminal and surrounds.
