# Instructions

## **Application Form**

- ► Select your council name from the drop down list. (F14)
- ► Enter contact details for the responsible officer. (F17 F20)

The remainder of the form is divided into two sections relating to **ordinary rate minimums** and **special rate minimums**. All non-shaded sections should be completed as relevant. The remaining cells/columns will populate automatically.

#### **Ordinary Rate Minimums**

- ► Enter each category or sub-category to which the proposed minimum amount/s will apply.
- ► Enter the minimum amount levied in 2012/13 and the proposed 2013/14 minimum amount for each category and sub-category. If a minimum amount was not levied in 2012/13, enter zero.
  - (The total increase in dollar and percentage terms will be calculated automatically for each category/sub-category)
- ► Enter the total number of assessments within each category or sub-category in 2012/13 and 2013/14, and the number of assessments that will be on the proposed minimum amount within each category or sub-category.

(The percentage of assessments on the minimum will be calculated automatically).

#### Special Rate Minimums

- ► Enter the name of the special rate to which the proposed minimum amount will apply.
- ▶ Enter the minimum amount levied in 2012/13 and the proposed 2013/14 minimum amount for each special rate. If a minimum amount was not levied in 2012/13 enter zero.

(The total increase in dollar and percentage terms will be calculated automatically for each category/sub-category)

▶ Enter the total number of assessments for each special rate in 2012/13 and 2013/14, and the number of assessments on the proposed minimum amount for each special rate (in 2012/13 and 2013/14).

(The percentage of assessments on the minimum will be calculated automatically).
