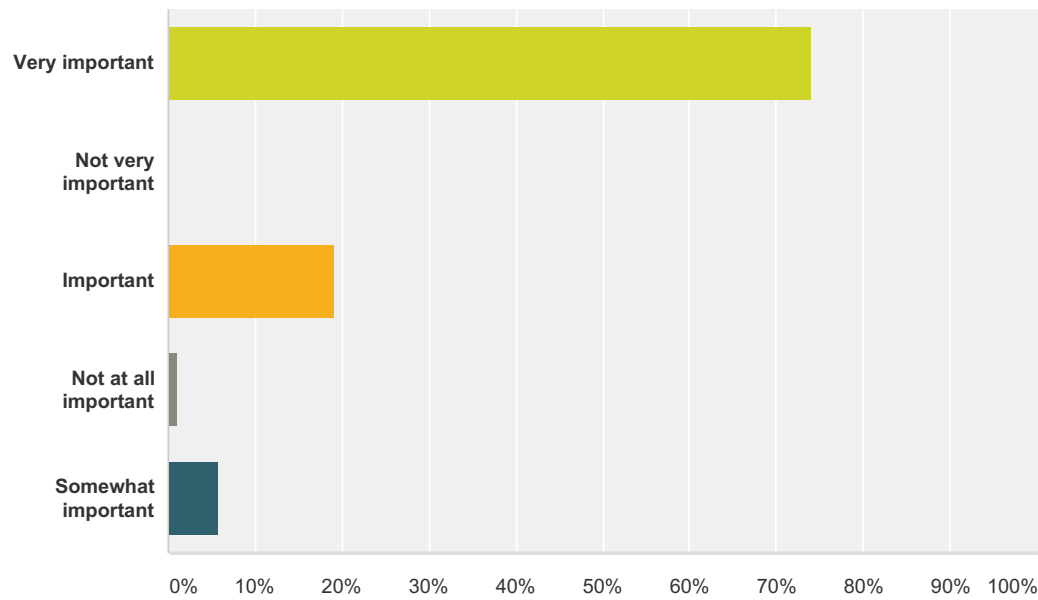


Q1 How important is your local Council to you?

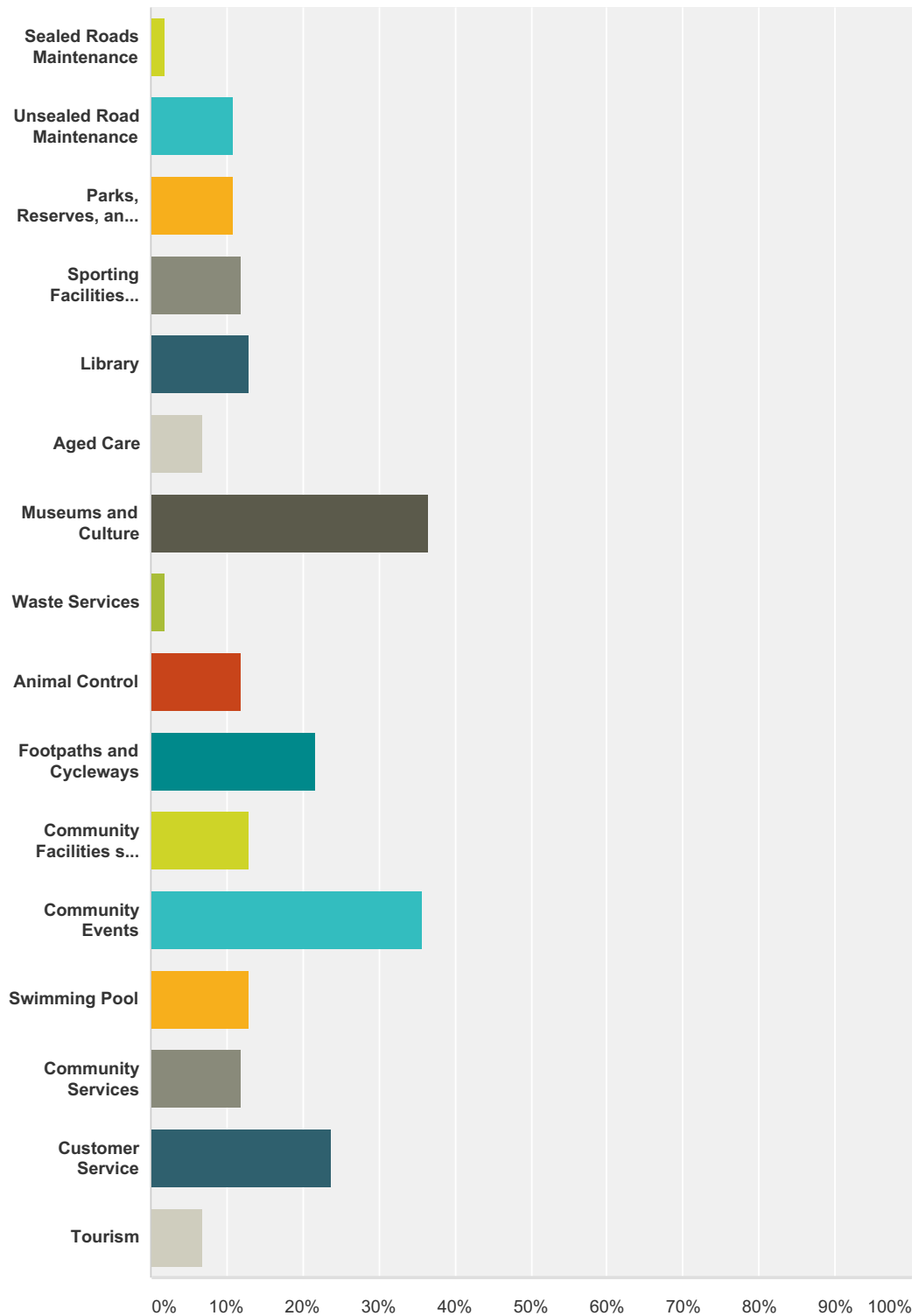

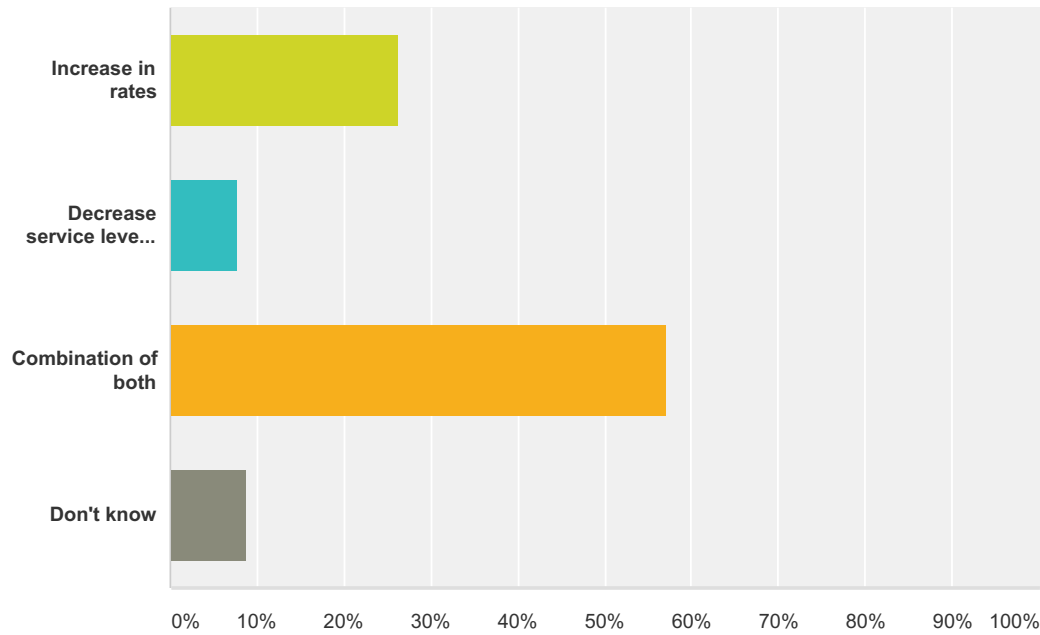
