KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

A maintenance technician will be responsible for the following matters:

- Prepare reports in relation to operations in the areas of responsibility
- Contribute knowledge and experience in relation to the preparation and implementation of standard operating procedures and other operational initiatives as required
