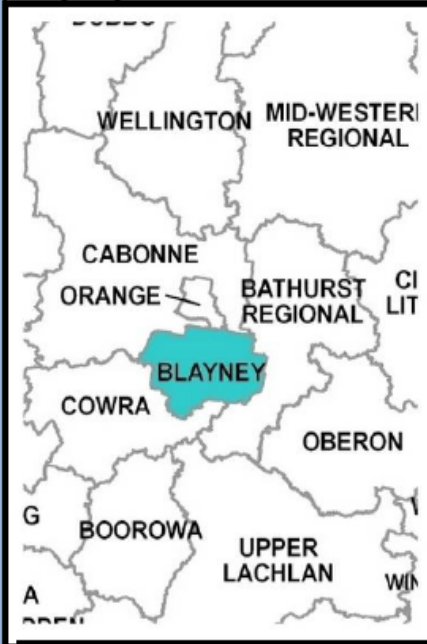


Blayney Shire Council

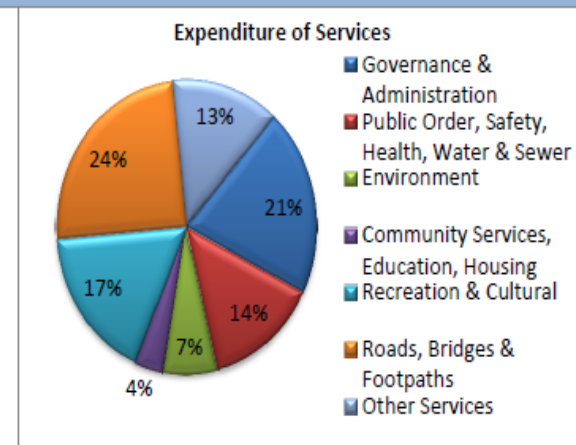

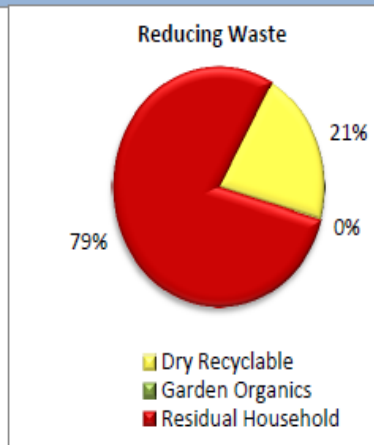

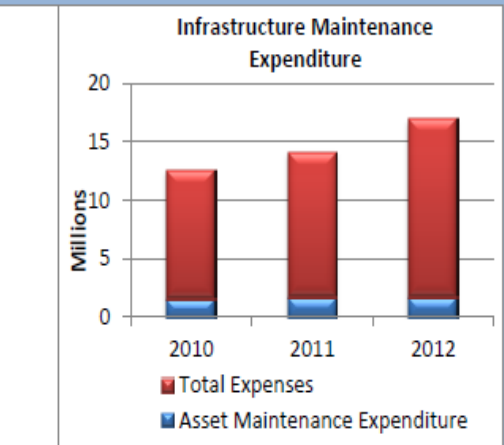
Your Council's Waste Services
