NOTICE OF EXTENSION TO THE TERM OF THE ICT AGREEMENT TO 30 JUNE 2025

We refer to the ICT Agreement (ICTA) between the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal of NSW (IPART) and Accenture Australia Pty Ltd (Accenture) with a commencement date of 23 December 2021, and as varied by the Deed of Variation signed on 22 December 2022 and subject to various change requests.

The term of the ICTA comprises an initial term of 3 years and any renewal period. Under the ICTA, IPART has 2 options to extend the Term by up to 12 months for each renewal.

The ICTA is currently due to expire on 23 December 2024.

In accordance with clause 5.2(a) of the ICTA, this letter provides written notice to Accenture of IPART's decision to exercise its sole discretion to extend the term of the ICTA for a period of 6 months.

The ICTA will now expire at the end of 30 June 2025 (unless terminated earlier or renewed again).

In accordance with clause 5.2(b), this Renewal Period is on the same terms and conditions as are currently in place. IPART is not seeking to further vary the terms and conditions.
