

# Applications to vary WIC Act licences for North Cooranbong Scheme

17 June 2022

## 1 Topic

Altogether Cooranbong Water Pty Ltd (Altogether Cooranbong) and Altogether Group Pty Ltd (Altogether Group) have applied to vary their network operator's licence (15\_033) and a retail supplier's licence (13\_001R), under the *Water Industry Competition Act 2006* (NSW) (the WIC Act)

The applications are for the North Cooranbong Scheme which currently provides drinking water, recycled water and sewerage services to the scheme's residential and commercial customers, in the City of Lake Macquarie local government area.

IPART is seeking comments from stakeholders as part of our assessment of Altogether Cooranbong and Altogether Group's applications.

## 2 Background

The North Cooranbong Scheme collects sewage from homes and businesses and treats the sewage to produce recycled water to be distributed back to homes and businesses through a recycled water reticulation network. The scheme also supplies drinking water from Hunter Water's drinking water network at the bulk supply point at Wainman Drive and delivers it to customers.

Altogether Cooranbong and Altogether Group have applied:

- to add new end-uses for recycled water (general washdown, street cleaning and use of process water at the recycled water treatment plant), and
- to expand the network and retail licence area of operations to supply recycled water, drinking water and sewerage services to additional customers.

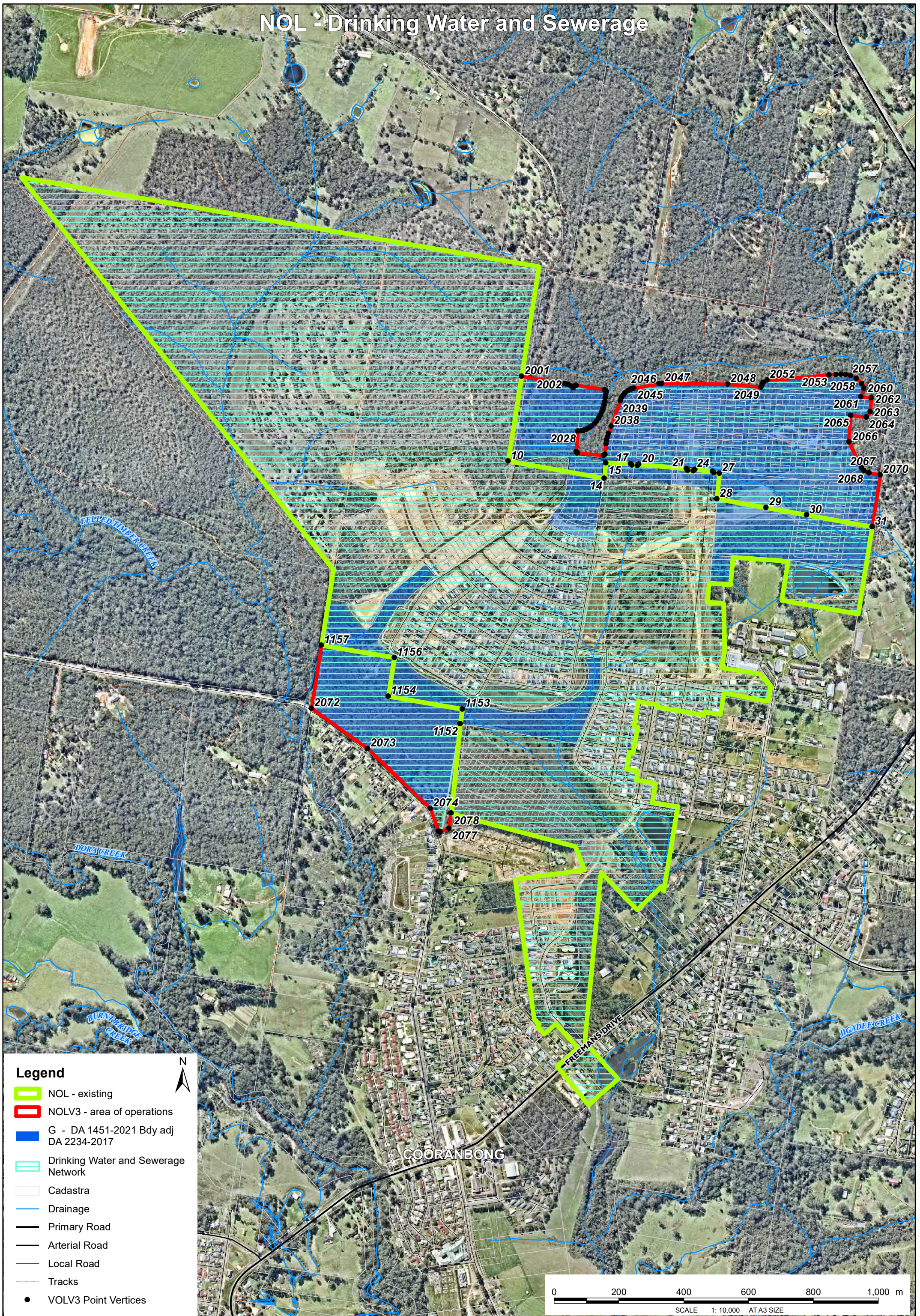

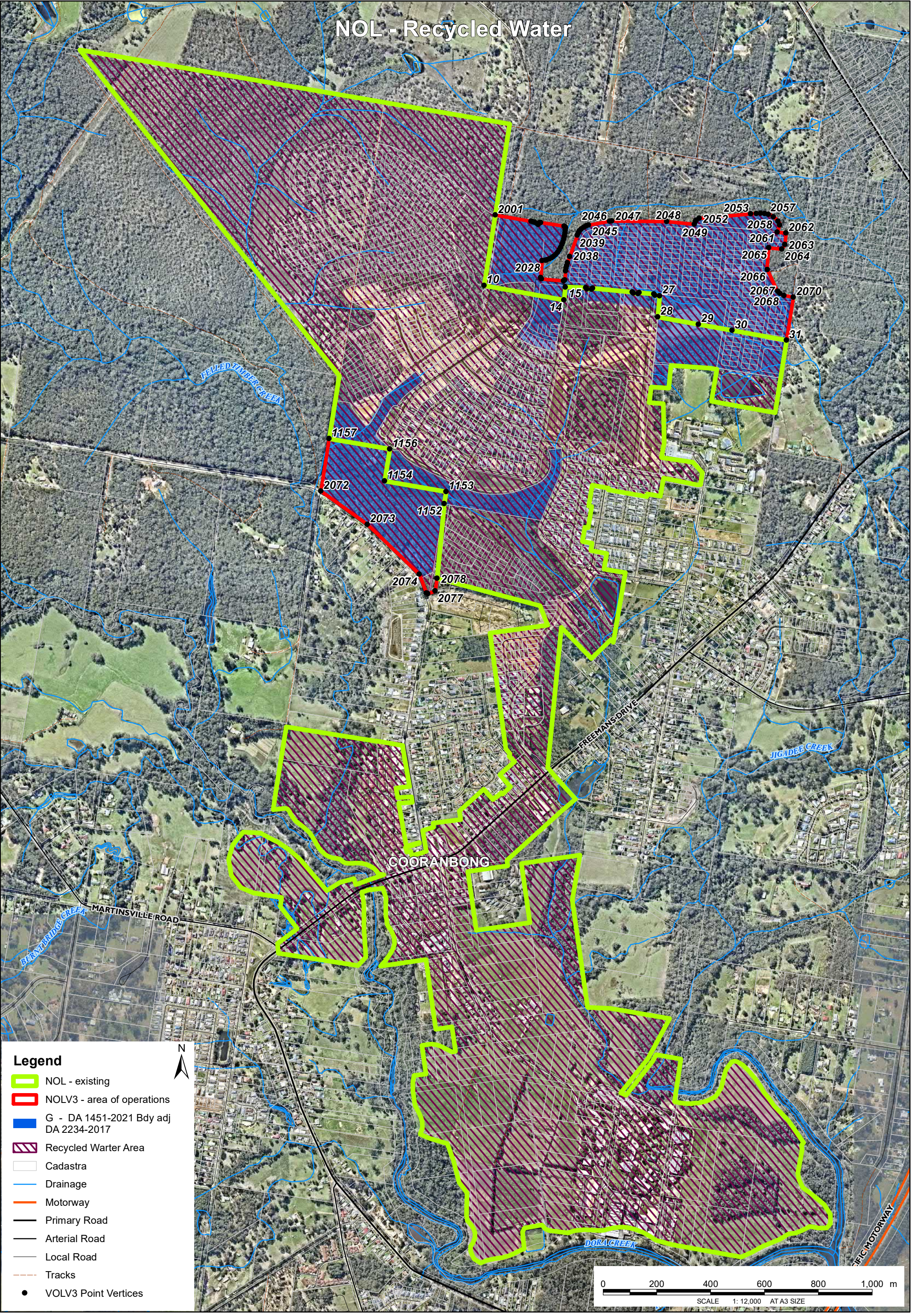


# NOL - Drinking Water and Sewerage



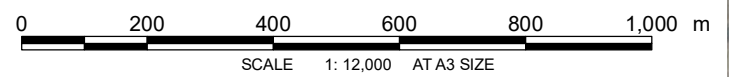


# NOL - Recycled Water



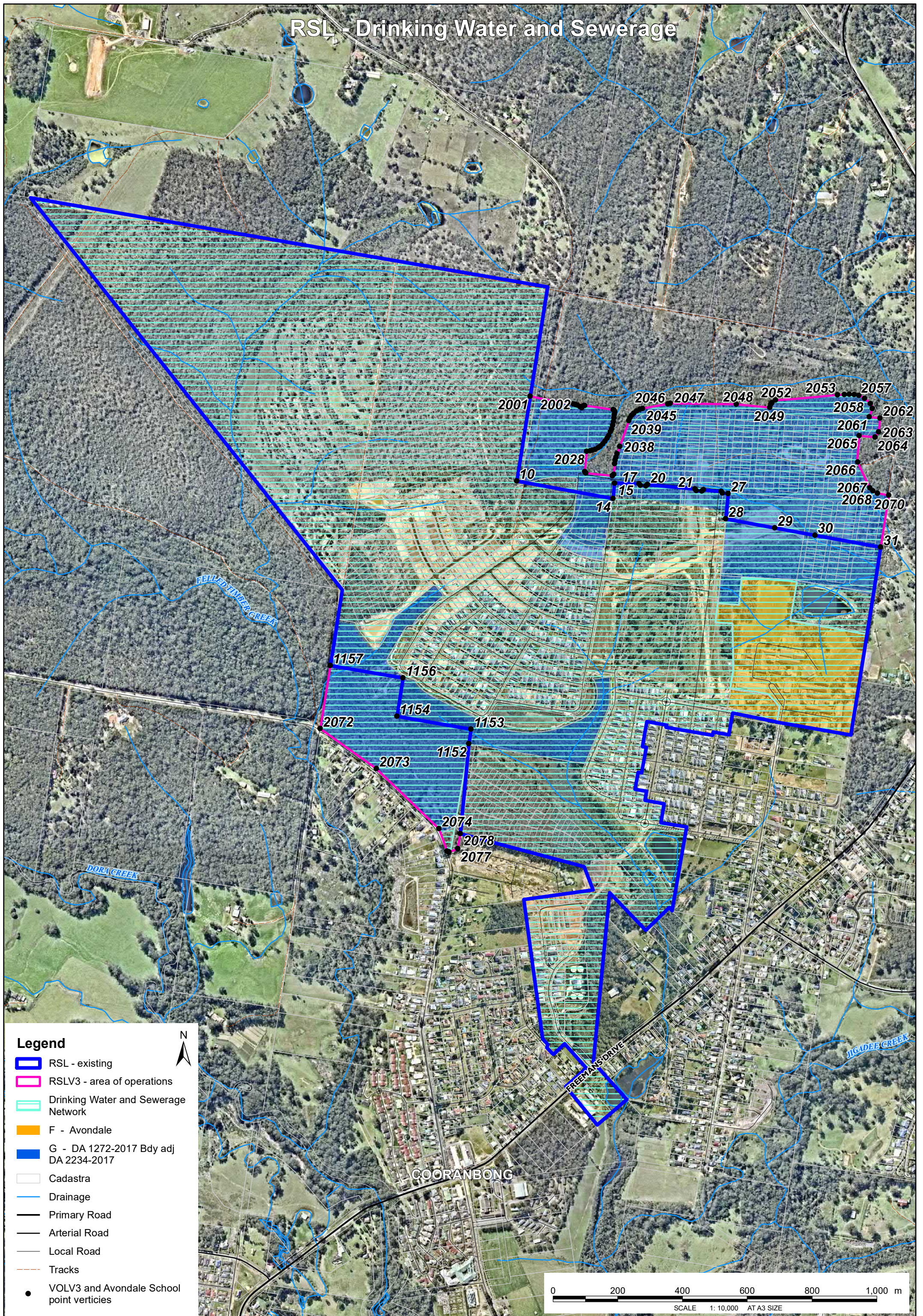
