## INSTRUMENT OF APPOINTMENT OF THE REGULATOR UNDER THE ELECTRICITY INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT ACT 2020 No.2



I, Matthew Kean MP, Minister for Energy and Environment, under section 64(1) of the *Electricity Infrastructure Investment Act 2020* (NSW) (the **Act**) appoint the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (**IPART**) as the regulator with effect from the Effective Date.

## 1. Term of appointment

The appointment instrument takes effect from the Effective Date and ends on the earlier of:

- (a) The time the appointment is terminated under section 68 of the Act, or
- (b) The time the IPART resigns the appointment under section 69 of the Act.

## 2. Regulator Functions

The IPART is appointed as the regulator under this instrument to carry out the functions of the regulator set out in section 8 of the Act, and any other regulatory functions in the relevant law not conferred on another person or entity from time to time.

This appointment is subject to the terms and conditions specified in this instrument and any limitations prescribed by the relevant law.

## 3. Definitions

Effective Date means the date this Instrument is executed.

function means functions, powers and duties.

relevant law means Electricity Infrastructure Investment Act 2020 (NSW) or another Act or law referred to in section 64(4)(c) of the Electricity Infrastructure Investment Act 2020 (NSW), and includes all delegated legislation or orders made under it and amendments, consolidations, replacements or re-enactments of any of them.
