## Council:

- A. resolves to apply for the Additional Special Variation (ASV) under section 508(2) of the Local Government Act 1993 (the Act) as a permanent special variation for the full 2.5 per cent rate increase,
- B. notes the additional income it will receive if the special variation is approved would be \$2.7 million in 2022-2023 and \$30 million over the period of the Long-Term Financial Plan 2022-2032,
- C. notes this income is necessary to ensure adequate maintenance of critical community infrastructure and meet the obligations set for 2022-2023 in the city's 2021-2022 Integrated Planning and Reporting (IP&R) documentation,
- b. has considered the impact on ratepayers and the community in 2022-2023 and in future years and considers this increase is reasonable, and
- E. notes the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART) will publish applications to enable community consultation and directs feedback on Council's ASV to IPART.
