



Instrument Under Section 548(3)(a) of the Local Government Act 1993

Minimum Rates for Narrandera Shire Council for 2024-25 to 2025-26

13 May 2024

This instrument is made by the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART) as delegate for the Minister administering the Local Government Act 1993 (Act) (delegation of 6 September 2010).

IPART determines under section 548(3)(a) of the Act that:

1. Narrandera Shire Council may make and levy the following minimum ordinary rates for Year 2024-25 to Year 2025-26 (inclusive):

Rating category or sub-category	Year 2024-25	Year 2025-26
Residential Ordinary	\$640	\$755
Business Ordinary	\$640	\$755
Business Narrandera	\$715	\$845
Farmland Ordinary	\$640	\$755

- 2. In the event that the minimum ordinary rates set out in this instrument for any Year between Year 2024-25 and Year 2025-26 (inclusive) are less than the minimum ordinary rates that could otherwise be determined under section 548(4) and (5) of the Act for that Year, the minimum ordinary rates may be determined for that Year under section 548(4) and (5) of the Act and those rates prevail over those set out in this instrument for that Year.
- 3. In this instrument:
 - a. **Year** means the period from 1 July to the following 30 June.
