Randwick City Council, special variation application.

I understand that Randwick Council has applied to IPART for an annual rate increase of 5.52% pa over the next three years. The justification for this increase was based on the results of a direct mail and telephone survey conducted by Council. The survey structure and results can be summarised based on the "Community Consultation Results Summary" as follows:

## 1. Structure

## (a) Mail survey

41804 surveys sent to ratepayers, 9546 surveys sent to Real Estate agents for property investors Total returned 5713 (11.13%)

## (b) Telephone survey

600 local residents conducted by Micromex

## 2. Results

The results which it is claimed support option 3 (5.52% inc) were 57% from the Telephone survey i.e. 342 and 49% from the mail survey returns i.e. 49%x5713=2780.

For ratepayers therefore only 2780 from a total of 51350 supported the rate increase. This is 5.4%. If the Telephone survey result is included it becomes 6%. **(NB** there is probably some duplication between Telephone survey participants and ratepayers).

This level of support surely cannot be used to justify a rate increase of this magnitude.
