Submission: As a Randwick Council ratepayer I have witnessed a number of special rate variation & levy being applied for & granted during the last 10 years. The council never seems to have enough revenue. The presentation of options in the survey was very biased & favoured the biggest increase. The response from ratepayer over the summer holidays was, not surprisingly, very low & it's hard to see how the council can claim that a majority of ratepayers are in favour of a 19+% rate increase. The justification for this rate rise is weak. The projects nominated are not really local government responsibilities and would be a drain on local resources.
