Your submission for this review:

Do not believe enough insight has been provided on the impact of reduced Feed in Tariffs (FIT) for those existing clients with Solar Panels. In my case FIT for last 12 months has been 22c pkh. New plan only offers maximum FIT of 07c pkh. This reduction of essentially 66% will mean an increase in our overall pa electricity bill. As pensioners we manage our power consumption carefully (70% in off peak under a Time of Use meter). Yes, we can shop around for a better FIT return but since separate IPART review of FIT best we can find, that suits our usage pattern, is 10c pkh...still significantly lower than current 22c pkh. All I believe the IPART review has done is flatten the FIT return to the detriment of those who do carefully manage their usage during peak TOU periods.
