This DWM study should consider the potential clawback of funds held by those holding the deposit funds for non returned containers associated with the Container Deposit Scheme introduced in 2017 . The percentage of containers not returned over a given period should form the basis of a direct charge to those holding the funds with a subsequent direct return of those funds to Councils on a proportionate basis (to be determined) to offset the cost of DWM as most of the non returned containers would no doubt be placed in recycling bins collected by Councils . This of course needs to be viewed in consideration of the ability of Councils to redeem these deposits in their own right
