I am contacting you into a number of issues regarding Federation Shire.

1. Corowa's Aquatic Centre (due to open April 2021) excessive admission prices for patrons.

Eg. A season's family ticket will cost \$500 and single entry tickets will set you back \$18.

Mind you there are 3 other swimming centres within the shire who have much lower admission prices.

Howlong Swim Centre has free admission I believe. Also Urana and Oaklands will need bringing up to speed in the coming years.

2.Sudden Rise In Debt. When Federation was formed in 2017 the NSW Govt gave The Organization 2 single Increments consisting of A) \$15Million B) 10Million within a very short time span.

Almost 4 yrs later The Council has consumed a debt of \$8 Million and only \$13Million in savings/cash reserves. As of Feb 2021. I have reason to believe all of that &25 Million was spent on a new fleet of vehicles etc.

Which I feel was totally unnecessary and a complete waste of money.

3.A 8.8% SRV to cover costs of Corowa Aquatic Centre running costs for 2021/2022. Expected to be over a \$Million. Out of towners may not support this center due to traveling costs. This will add to the debt no doubt
