Dear Sir/ Madame.

I am contacting you into a number of issues regarding Federation Shire.

1. Corowa's Aquatic Centre (due to open April 2021) excessive admission prices for patrons.

Eg. A season's family ticket will cost \$500 and single entry tickets will set you back \$18.

Mind you there are 3 other swimming centres within the shire who have much lower admission prices.

Howlong Swim Centre has free admission I believe. Also Urana and Oaklands will need bringing up to speed in the coming years.

2. Sudden Rise In Debt. When Federation was formed in 2017 the NSW Govt gave The Organization 2 single Increments consisting of A) \$15 Million B) 10 Million within a very short time span.

Almost 4 yrs later The Council has consumed a debt of \$8 Million and only \$13 Million in savings/cash reserves. As of Feb 2021. I have reason to believe all of that & 25 Million was spent on a new fleet of vehicles etc.

Which I feel was totally unnecessary and a complete waste of money.

3. A 8.8% SRV to cover costs of Corowa Aquatic Centre running costs for 2021/2022. Expected to be over a \$Million. Out of towners may not support this center due to traveling costs. This will add to the debt no doubt
