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Your submission for this review:

There are parts of the Central Coast which are not kerbed and guttered. There is basic or no drainage in these streets. There is a pattern of major roads having gutters and drainage (sometimes only on one side of the road) and in portions of adjoining streets the gutters continue. But there is widespread inconsistency. In high rate paying (high land value) suburbs there are streets with no gutters, or poor drainage. It is unfair that ratepayers who live on streets not kerbed and not guttered are being asked to pay more for "water, sewerage and drainage" costs . There is no differentiation in the Water Rates charged for residences on kerbed and guttered streets and rates charged for residences on unguttered and unkerbed streets with poor drainage.
