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Submission: Hi I am a resident and ratepayer and would like to complain about the recent rate survey sent from Randwick City Council. Firstly, the survey had 3 options on it on which Randwick City Council had their preferred option listed as the "recommended option" I think this would have puzzled a lot of our senior residents and non english speakers and was skewed towards having them think that it was the right option. I have never seen a survey with these options before. I personally thought the option entitled "Do Nothing Option" was as an affront to myself as a ratepayer and I think it infers you don't care. Only 5% responded to the survey which I don't think reflects the views of the whole community and only 600 phone calls out of over 50,000 residents, please.
