Your submission for this review:

We find it contemptible that all energy suppliers pay either 4 or 7 feed-in tariffs to consumers when power is forwarded to the grid. The power suppliers then sell this excess up to 7 times more to consumers. There is no incentive for consumers to install solar panels. Electricity bills should spell out the peak, shoulder, off-peak and control rates proportionately to the base cost and not leave consumers in the dark as to the percentages of these costs.
