Subject: Mid Coast Council Proposed Rate Increase

I am writing to object to the appointed Administrator for the Mid Coast Council's decision to apply for a 28.5% rate increase over four years including 11% for the 2017-2017 year.

The NSW Government stated that there would be NO rate increases for amalgamated councils for four years from the date of amalgamation however someone in their "wisdom" has decided that this promise need not apply to Mid Coast Council.

The proposal to amalgamate The Manning, Gloucester and Great Lakes Councils was initiated by the Gloucester and Manning Councils who are well known for being financial basket cases however the proposal was supported by the Great Lakes Councils.
