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Your submission for this review:

1. I AGREE with a 3 year determination period. 2. WaterNSW should focus on reducing costs at all stages of storage and delivery. 3. Safety-related costs should be included with WaterNSW Greater Sydney prices from 1 October 2025, if the rest of the Rural Valleys are being charged. 4. Great Sydney prices must fairly reflect the resources they consume in WaterNSW. 5. Safety related costs should be borne by the State, since the biggest holders and users of water are State entities, not private farmers. 6. IPART should adjust WaterNSW current Rural Valley prices to account for changes in water sales volumes from 2021. Higher volumes are being used after that date. 7. The Yanco Creek levy SHOULD remain remain at \$0.90 per ML unless a change is agreed by YACTAC (Yanco Creek and Tributaries Advisory Committee). 8. IPART should be considering that the pure "user pays" principle being applied is not applicable to an historic system that has generated vast revenue for the State, and created communities. 9. The storage and supply systems are used by many in the community for recreation and tourism, and our first nations communities are connected to the water ways. 10. "User pays" is routinely ignored in other state commodities like urban public transport, electricity supply, and road maintenance.
