I write as a permanent resident and Midcoast Council ratepayer to <u>STRONGLY OPPOSE</u> the proposed Council Rate increase .

The amalgamation of our council was, in my opinion, against the wishes of the residents of Tea Gardens/ Hawks Nest, who strongly opposed it, but were ignored.

<u>The MCC Administrator was APPOINTED, NOT ELECTED</u> and thus has no ratepayer mandate to implement such far- reaching changes in the immediate future, before the planned Council election next September.

Also, it was only last February, that Council stated there would be no need for a future rate increase. Then <u>MCC was mysteriously exempted from restrictions</u> to merged councils from applying for rate increases for 4 years.

This proposal will mean within 3 years our rates will have <u>INCREASED to \$3,400</u> annually, which will make them <u>higher than some city rates!</u>

Over the past 20 years, the previous GLC instituted numerous increases to rates, well above the CPI. <u>Tea Gardens / Hawks Nest residents are largely on fixed incomes</u>, totally governed by the CPI, and these proposed annual increases will have a <u>DEVASTATING</u> effect on our future financial security.

Dr Boxall, you are urged to reject this proposal immediately.
