Below is the letter we submitted in 2013 and progress on this matter seems to have stalled. We see no reason to change our earlier point of view—this is basically "the Walcha Community wishes to maintain its independence".

To the Independent Local Government review panel

Re: Walcha needs to be Independent

As Walcha residents/ratepayers we and other residents wish to maintain our own separate identity for Walcha.

Being able to meet and speak with our council on a face to face basis and see the results is something one would never expect or receive from a larger council. (Having previously lived in Tamworth where we found that different sections of the Council there don't even speak to each other).
