In addition to my submission lodged earlier, I am totally convinced that IPART's agenda is to lower the amount paid for the FIT to the lowest possible to ensure both the Federal and State Governments proposal of alternative power through solar,wind,hydrogen and pumped Hydro ,ensures that these projects become viable.
