Submission: Gundagai Shire Council is very incompetent and continues to go on in an aberrant manner. The latest example of this is the Council forming a Committee to have a statue of the part Aboriginal man, Coonong Dennyamundinna aka Yarry who with several other white and part or full Aboriginal men saved some lives in the 1852 Gundagai Flood after being ordered to do so by the Crown Commissioner. Council formed a statue committee, did not consult with the wider community about Yarry or the intended statue even though they knew of the disgusting side to Yarry many many months ago, and just barrel on regardless of community opinion re erecting a statue of a [REDACTED] in our main street. I had to letterbox the town to inform them as the local not Independent paper was obviously cooperating with keeping Gundagai not informed. After I letterboxed it then broke in the paper even though they would not even accept my paid advertisement about Yarry let alone a Letter to the Editor from me. The Council does not have the skill base required to apply usual Australian values and professional behaviours to some things it gets involved with.
