We wish to lodge an objection to the proposal by Maitland City Council to increase the rates for the oncoming (seven) years. We have had two exorbitant increases over the past 2 years and we find that the current request for increase is outrageous in the current situation.

The Council plans to open the Mall at a cost of \$17million, to one way traffic and repave it at a considerable cost to ratepayers with tiles - not from Australia - but Italy, costing \$820,000.00. That is a joke. The ratepayers are tightening their belts only to have Council letting their's loose.

As for the phone survey of ratepayers, I (Joan) was called, only to have my comments rejected as the company conducting the survey had enough of my age group accounted for (ie. Over 65 years).
