On their website read: The Three options: 7.5%, 10%, 12.5%

All the 3 OPTIONS rate rise included the NSW State Government's estimated rate peg of 2.5%; they also have varying impacts and service quality. At the end of the 4 year period the SPECIAL RATE VARIATION increase would be built into the general rate base and permanently retained.

The above booklet re the 3 OPTIONS was included in the BSC rates notices.

The actual online survey showed 4 OPTIONS - NOT 3!
