
balancing community expectations

Council only listened to what it wanted to hear, anything they didn't want to hear was dismissed or glossed over. They split the consultation into (3) three options to consider, they wanted your preference to show how the SRV would go ahead. The overwhelming majority of people were against the SRV, why can't LCC operate with the high rate structure we already pay.

NOT a lot of constructive community consultation, they put it out there but it hasn't got through (unreasonable). People don't come forward like they should, it's a waste of time trying to communicate with them, council doesn't get the true feel of the people it looks after. People don't know how to make a submission against. They leave it to others.

### THE IMPACT

We already have a good Business district, But it not vibrant as it was. Because people are feeling the pinch. Shops are just closing up, not selling on (lots and lots and lots) The flood may have had something to do with this (why bother) sales are down for sure & running costs are high, commercial rates higher than average. Lots of factors involved.

Not to mention the economy out there, \$ numbers are two high eg. How are our children ever going to be able to save for a deposit and buy a home, let alone get a \$500,000.00 loan. couples each have to have a very good job. Even ours flood prone houses in Lismore are around \$300,000. at the bottom end of sales.

LCC hasn't got a clue what's going on out there in Lismore Town and how tight it is with living costs.

We own an old wooden flood prone house in [REDACTED] and we don't go out hardly. [REDACTED] works 3 days at [REDACTED] and I

have some rents coming in to survive on. [REDACTED] is 64 and I am 70, we can't get the pension or part of. we live within our means amongst renters and low income neighbour hood.

We know first hand the trouble there is. How do you know? You know how they live, Print Drug & Fight. But it the stress factor that is the main thing you see. we keep to ourselves as much as we can. LCC can spend and say as much as they like but it won't make a scrap of difference to the vibrance and confidence in Lismore.

(more living pressure, more stress.) across the board. **IMPORTANT:** It's the hidden ones that snap.


No one trusts the council to do exactly what they say. Any money in general fund is fair game to do what they want.

# 4 of 9 IPART THE NEED & IMPACT

It's a case of too much too late for LCC. Lismore has a fragile economy, there's cracks through all parts of the community. People in Lismore have learnt to live within these means, they don't need or want more Bill's Pressure, everything is so expensive.

LCC has been pushing sports tourism ever since they put the gabion second hand grandstand [REDACTED] on the Public Park Land in Lismore central 25 years ago and has been handed onto every successive council ever since, now \$20 million (around that) and LCC are wanting more for economic development. The (2) ovals OAK's of Crozer and associated infrastructure have been a bottomless pit. Lismore city council has been getting money from anywhere it can.

And now yet another grant of 6 million\$. Modelling projections indicate LCC can pay for it in three years? They are only projections, you first have to actually get the events. You can count on one hand the number of external events LCC has attracted to Lismore central ovals, in 20 years.

They don't dare mention the ovals straight out for economic development. Touchy subject. People know the waste that's take place.

Here is what [REDACTED] said about the SRV (Dec 2019.) Mr Smith told ABC North Coast the 25 a day rise will go towards Lismore's biggest asset (another up-grade.) that's the two ovals OAK's of Crozer.

He also said it was the council's role to ensure important infrastructure projects were carried out (DEC 2019)

The sport fanatic's have got him.

It's a touchy topic in Lismore, the fanatic's say your either with us or your anti-sport. That's right, that's exactly what they said when they illegally put the grandstand in the open Lismore Park. fences every now.

\$2.3 million annually he said. So councils contribution will  
be paid for in three years?

"me." as before its been going on for 20 years under the same  
Banner, saying people will come to the city.

And nothing has happened, only local club's games.

you can count on one hand how many outside Bigger games

have been played on oaks oval the main one, none  
on Crozer oval. in 20 years. But the overspending has never  
stopped on the ovals

Again new Lismore [REDACTED] defended the expenditure of millions  
on more upgrades to crozer and oaks oval, as council  
struggles to deal with its \$6 million budget Black Hole (Bad [REDACTED])  
the Black hole just gets bigger, it just didn't happen all  
of a sudden, its been there and happening for quite awhile,  
hidden somewhere out of sight till it just popped out in sight.

If that misappropriation happened in the private sector, they  
would be in the [REDACTED] we still do not know where it went.  
to or what they were, the \$ went somewhere (it gone) ?  
they cut future projects and services to level the books.

But now they want an extra .6 million off us Rate Payers  
in the form of a SRV to Bale them out.

Rate Pegging is in place to protect us the Rate payers from councils that are out of touch with the electorate. The ones that follow their own agenda. ✓ and incompetent. the [REDACTED] and debt of 6 million \$ was enough for me, they cut services not needed to level the books. But its still missing. It was announced just before the SRV was announced. Now they want 6 million from Rate Payers to plug the Black Hole By Raising Rates. They want us to bale them OUT for the [REDACTED]

They can't say its only 25 per day each and every day for 4 years. It more than that, its 24% extra over 4 years above and over our Rates we pay now and it compounds. After 4 years it stays as our normal rate, then the new peg kicks in (Rates are through the roof now) without any SRV. we have to find + ten every quarter. we not here to go broke paying Rates to a council who wastes our money.

\* Rate Payers do care about the amount of money they pay in Rates, everyone I have spoken to are against the SRV. everyone is impacted by the cost of living, let alone be interested in a SRV. NO-one is willing to support it.

IN THE consultation any one in Lismore Area can make a submission anyone. But only Rate payers foot the Bill. Renters etc also don't benefit from the SRV either. As I have written under. Renters will be Doing it tough in the longer Run. Its not fair to the Rate payers or the Renter, Young Families, who may have a mortgage, first Home Buyers, pensioners who live from fortnight to fortnight, Farmer who have coped it. AND Retailers who are falling by the way side.

Rates are as high as they have ever been without this SRV. Rate payers don't mind paying set Rates each year and the set Peg. But now its a joke, and people are not laughing, "Laughable" approx 2.5% But Double Dipping "No. THE system has been broken."

LCC can't have everthing at once.


