As a resident in this council – I have lived in Woolloomooloo for over 11 years and have worked in the Sydney CBD for 30 years, I oppose expanding the boundaries for this council.

The key concerns are :

- retaining multiple key positions in a combined Council that would be not cost effect and highly confrontational.
- The needs of residents in the CBD vary considerably to those in suburban areas such as Randwick, Botany etc.
- Combining the planning controls that impact CBD buildings vs. purely residential homes would be ineffective
- Combining the infrastructure systems alone would be costly, timely and most likely not compatible
- Auckland City Council increased their zoning and it has not been effective for that Council
- The anticipated cost reductions have not occurred when other councils have expanded
