Q1 response:

I believe that Hawkesbury Residents should be separate from Sydney Water and pay their own bills.

Q2 response

We do not want development of Western Sydney to use our existing capacity at all. Places such as Marsden Park, Kellyville, Box Hill, Hills of Carmel, and Vineyard, already have constraints upon them, for their future expansion. The upgraded wastewater services in the Hawkesbury should be kept for future developments of Hawkesbury Residents. This includes Industrial, Residential (including granny flats) and Commercial properties.

The last thing we need is more waste water going west from all the new developments in Blacktown and the Hills districts. The Hawkesbury River and South Creek are already impacted from its own wastewater. Luckily the Hawkesbury Residents built and designed their treatment plants for their future and growth.
