Rates rises are not affordable.

I was told by a council employer last year that the rise last year would be the last one and now this year we are confronted by a proposed further rises over the next 3 years as well. Council has not disclosed its intentions re rates adequately.

The only way forward is for council to improve efficiencies within their own operations, limit increase in their internal pay rises, minimise employees on the top paying wage packages.

I heard some talk years ago of charging per household for the amount of sever they create, as a single person household I am subsiding larger multi person households with my sever rates, and garbage rates, of which I use very little, and general rates only driving on roads occasionally(cannot afford to drive often), where as other households have multiple cars are use roads often.
