Your submission for this review:

The proposed massive increases in water entitlement and water use charges are unacceptable. They represent an increase of more than 135% on average, with little or no transparency as the reasons for this increase. Service provision has not increased, but costs are proposed to increase at more than 5 times the rate of inflation - how can this be justified? The changes will negatively impact the people, businesses and communities of regional NSW, who are already being hit hard by continued water reforms. The impact on farming and farming communities will be real and significant and will be felt at a time where broad water reforms are already going to be tearing into the fabric of our small communities like Coleambally. IPART must reject these proposed price increases, demand efficient service from government bodies swollen with red tape and ensure that the same be achieved for less.
