





### Water Industry Competition Act 2006 Section 7K(14) Notice of decision – Replacement of operational approval Approval No. 24\_0400A

The Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (**IPART**) grants a replacement approval to correct errors and mis-descriptions in the operational approval 24\_0400A for the Huntlee scheme under section 7K(14) of the *Water Industry Competition Act 2006* (**Act**).

The replacement approval takes effect on 16 June 2025.

In granting the replacement approval, IPART was satisfied that the operational approval 24\_0400A, as in force since 23 September 2024, contained obvious errors and mis-descriptions.

## Approval Terms

#### 1. Grant and authorisation

- 1.1 The Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal grants this approval under section 7K(14) of the Act.
- **1.2** This approval authorises the registered operator to operate the authorised infrastructure for the authorised purposes in accordance with the specifications set out in this approval.
- 1.3 This clause authorises the registered operator to carry out certain activities that would otherwise be prohibited under section 6A of the Act. This authorisation does not provide an exemption from obligations under other laws unless expressly provided by those laws.

#### 2. Approval conditions

2.1 The authorisation in this approval is subject to the standard approval conditions specified in Schedule C, Item C2 and the special approval conditions specified in Schedule C, Item C3.

Note: The Act and Regulations contain additional conditions.

#### 3. Interpretation

- 3.1 Expressions used in this approval that are defined in the Act or Regulations have the meanings set out in the Act or the Regulation unless the context otherwise requires.
- 3.2 In this approval, unless the context otherwise requires:
  - (a) the singular includes the plural and vice versa,
  - (b) a reference to this approval includes any schedule to this approval,
  - (c) a reference to a schedule is to a schedule to this approval, and
  - (d) explanatory notes and headings do not form part of this approval, but in the case of uncertainty may be relied on for interpretation purposes.
- 3.3 In this approval:

Act means the Water Industry Competition Act 2006.

**authorised infrastructure** means the water industry infrastructure specified in the related scheme approval.

**authorised purposes** mean the purposes specified for the relevant infrastructure in the final column of the approval authorisation table.

Regulations means any regulations made under the Act.

**related scheme approval** means the scheme approval identified as such in the final column of the approval authorisation table.

## Schedule C Approval conditions

### Item C1 Interpretation

If any condition, or part of any condition, is unlawful, that condition, or part of the condition, is severable and does not affect the validity of the approval or the balance of the conditions or condition.

### Item C2 Standard approval conditions

### C2.1 Limitations on which infrastructure may be operated

- 2.1.1 The registered operator must operate only that authorised infrastructure which is either:
  - (a) existing infrastructure; or
  - (b) infrastructure that extends or expands existing infrastructure, but only if the infrastructure:
    - (i) involves the same technology as that used in connection with the existing infrastructure, and
    - (ii) is consistent with any applicable asset management plan or system, water quality management system, and sewage management plan or system for the existing infrastructure; and
    - (iii) is in the area of operations specified in Schedule H of the related scheme approval; and
    - (iv) is located in the location specified in Schedule I of the related scheme approval, unless the infrastructure is pipelines within the reticulation network.
- 2.1.2 In this condition C2.1, **existing infrastructure** means that authorised infrastructure which existed at 26 November 2020.

### Item C3 Special approval conditions

### C3.1 Permitted end-uses for recycled water

3.1.1 The registered operator must ensure water industry infrastructure for the scheme supplies recycled water to customers for only the permitted end-uses specified in Table C3.1 below.

### Table C3.1

- 1. Car washing
- 2. Clothes washing
- 3. Dust suppression
- 4. General wash-down
- 5. Irrigation
- 6. Ornamental water features
- 7. Process water at recycled water treatment plant
- 8. Street cleaning
- 9. Toilet flushing
- 3.1.2 In this condition C3.1, ornamental water feature means a water feature that:
  - (a) is provided primarily for aesthetic or beautification purposes, and
  - (b) does not, by its design or accessibility, encourage interaction with the water.

#### C3.2 Environmental risk mitigation measures

- 3.2.1 The registered operator must implement environmental risk mitigation measures substantially consistent with the environmental risk mitigation measures identified in the REF where the registered operator carries out any activities authorised by this approval.
- 3.2.2 In this condition C3.2, **REF** means the documents titled:
  - (a) "Review of Environmental Factors for the Proposed Sewage, Recycled Water and Drinking Water Reticulation Systems", version 4, prepared by RPS Australia East Pty Ltd and dated June 2015; and
  - (b) "Review of Environmental Factors for the Extension of a Sewage Reticulation System, North Rothbury", version 3, prepared by RPS Australia East Pty Ltd and dated June 2015;
  - (c) "Review of Environmental Factors for the Huntlee Local Water Centre", version 4, prepared by RPS Australia East Pty Ltd and dated June 2015;

and does not include any modified version of those documents or any documents replacing them.
