Background on WIC Act

- A new licensing & access regime for private sector entrants into the water industry commenced on 8
 August 2008 with the enactment of the WIC Act & its regulations
- Private corporations that wish to supply water or provide sewerage services must obtain a licence
- The Act is part of the NSW Government's strategy for a sustainable water future
- The Act aims to harness the innovation & investment potential of the private sector in the water & wastewater industries & to promote competition

Key areas of WIC Act and Regulations

The Act establishes:

- a licensing regime for private sector entrants to ensure the continued protection of public health, consumers and the environment
- an access regime to ensure that certain monopoly infrastructure services are available to persons seeking access to them
- binding arbitration of sewer mining disputes, where service provider has lodged a notice with IPART indicating willingness to allow disputes to be referred for arbitration

Regulations

- There are two Regulations under the Act:
- General Regulation
 - matters that must be addressed in licence applications
 - standard licence conditions
 - register of licences
 - RoLR provisions
 - establishes various Codes
- Access Regulation
 - provides for coverage declarations, access undertakings and access determinations
