Local residents have answered the call by helping Council develop a preferred option as part of the **2013 Rates and Services Review**. The community is now invited to learn more at information sessions across our City.

“I am encouraging all residents to attend our information sessions, or stop at an information stall, to find out more about the community’s preferred option, and also have their questions answered,” Mayor Brian Robson said.



“The **Have Your Say Canterbury** campaign has involved our community in exploring options for changes in the range and level of services, and the ways by which we can fund these, to ensure the City of Canterbury remains a great place to live, work and play.

“Through a range of activities, including the formation of a Community Working Group, we have informed and gathered feedback from as many people as possible.

“The information sessions and stalls will detail what we have heard during this process and the preferred direction the community has chosen to take our City.

“We have experienced increases in population over the past five years, and expect more increases in the future, but this population increase produces a strain on Council’s ability to provide services and maintain infrastructure.

“Working with the community through the Have Your Say campaign has been a real success and I think residents will be pleased with the outcomes and what the future holds for the City of Canterbury.
