Hours of operation of Christmas / New Year

Our **Administration Centre** will be closed from 1pm on Tuesday, 24 December 2013. We will also be closed on Christmas Day - Wednesday, 25 December 2013, Boxing Day - Thursday, 26 December 2013 and New Year's Day - Wednesday, 1 January 2014.

Children's Centres, Occasional Care and Family Day Care will close on Monday, 23 December 2013, with Children's Centres and Occasional Care re-opening on Tuesday, 14 January 2014.

Family Day Care will re-commence operations on Thursday, 2 January 2014.



Out of School Hours Care will close on Wednesday 18 December 2013 and re-open on Wednesday, 29 January 2014.

Vacation care will be provided commencing Thursday 19 – Monday, 23 December 2013 and then on Thursday, 2 January 2014 until Tuesday, 28 January 2014.

Libraries - Campsie Central and all library branches will operate as follows:

- 25 December - 26 December - All libraries closed
- 27 December - Campsie Library open 10.00am – 5.00pm
- 28 December - Campsie Library open 9.30am – 4.00pm

- 30 December - 31 December - Campsie Library open 10.00 – 5.00 pm
- 27 December - 31 December - Branch libraries closed
- 1 January 2013 - All libraries closed
- 2 January 2013 - All libraries resume normal hours of operation

Belmore Youth Resource Centre will be closed from Wednesday, 25 December 2013 to Wednesday, 1 January 2014 inclusive.

DA-512/2013 - an application for the demolition of existing structures and erection of a 5 storey mixed use development with additional attic level, comprising 4 x 1 bed, 18 x 2 bed residential units and 1 commercial tenancy including 3 level basement car parking at 23 Weyland Street, Punchbowl.
