DA-569/2013 - an application for the construction of a six storey residential flat building containing 5 x 1 bedroom apartments, 11 x 2 bedroom apartments and 9 x 3 bedroom apartments with 2 levels of basement car parking at 104 and 106 Clissold Parade Campsie.
