

Hunter Water operating licence review

Invitation for submissions - Final

The Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART) is conducting a review of the Hunter Water operating licence.

IPART has released the draft operating licence package which consists of a draft report, draft operating licence, draft customer contract, draft cost-benefit analysis and draft reporting manual. It provides the proposed operating licence changes, with our reasons and analysis, to assist interested parties in making submissions. All submissions are due by 3 March 2017.

As part of this review, the Tribunal will be conducting a workshop in Newcastle on 21 February 2017. Details of this workshop will be available on IPART's website closer to the date.
