

IPART seeks feedback on utilities' proposed prices and costs for water management and rural bulk water services

Invitation for feedback

The Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART) has begun its review of prices and costs for water management services provided by the Water Administration Ministerial Corporation (WAMC). We are also reviewing prices and costs for rural bulk water services provided by Water NSW.

We are seeking feedback on utilities' proposed prices and increases in costs that will take effect from 1 July 2021.

We have released Issues Papers for both price reviews on our website along with WAMC's and Water NSW's pricing proposals (www.ipart.nsw.gov.au).
