Determination of CityRail and STA Fares

*(Sydney Morning Herald, Daily Telegraph, Illawarra Mercury and Newcastle Herald,
Friday 4 April 2003)*

The Tribunal is conducting an investigation into the determination of maximum fares for declared government monopoly passenger transport services to be charged from 1 September 2003 by State Rail Authority CityRail services (SRA – ref: 02/262) and State Transit Authority bus and ferry services (STA – ref: 03/16).

The Tribunal has requested submissions from each of the transport agencies be submitted by 28 April 2003.

The Tribunal invites submissions from other stakeholders and interested parties. To allow consideration of the pricing proposals and information submitted by the transport agencies, submissions from other stakeholders will be required by 30 May 2003.

A public hearing will be held on Thursday 19 June 2003 at the Tribunal's offices, with the Tribunal's determination released in August in time for implementation by 1 September 2003.
