**Determination of Passenger Transport Fares from July 2002**

The Tribunal is conducting an investigation into the determination of maximum fares for declared government monopoly passenger transport services to be charged from July 2002 by State Rail Authority CityRail services and State Transit Authority bus and ferry services.

The Tribunal has received submissions from each of the transport agencies, outlining their proposed fare changes and the main reasons for these changes.

Due to the delay in receiving the agency submissions, the Tribunal is extending the time originally allowed for the receipt of submissions from other stakeholders/interested parties.

Submissions from other stakeholders/interested parties will be required by 30 April 2002.

Unless confidentiality is sought, the submissions are generally available for public inspection at the Tribunal's offices and will be promptly placed on our website in PDF format and remain there until 3-4 weeks after the release of an inquiry report. The Tribunal exercises its discretion not to exhibit any submissions based on their length or content (containing material that is defamatory, offensive, or in breach of any law).

A public hearing has been scheduled for 10 May, with the Tribunal's determination released in June.
