



## Review of bus and ferry fares

### **Notice of extension to due date for submissions**

IPART is reviewing fares for NSW bus services, private ferry services and Newcastle bus and ferry services.

IPART is inviting public submissions on fare proposals from the Bus and Coach Association (non-metropolitan buses), the Commercial Vessel Association (private ferries) and the Ministry of Transport (metropolitan buses and Newcastle services).

Fare proposals for non-metropolitan buses and private ferries are now available from the IPART website ([www.ipart.nsw.gov.au](http://www.ipart.nsw.gov.au)). IPART has not yet received the fare proposal for metropolitan buses and Newcastle services.

IPART has extended the due date for public submissions to ensure that all fare proposals can be fully considered.

Public submissions for non-metropolitan buses and private ferries are now due by 26 October 2007. IPART will advise the new due date for submissions relating to metropolitan buses and Newcastle services once the Ministry of Transport's fare proposal is received.

Details on how to make a submission are available from the IPART website.

A public hearing for the review will now be held in early November 2007 at IPART's offices. Further details of the hearing will be advised on the IPART website in late October.
