



Review of fares for Stockton and private ferry services

IPART is currently reviewing maximum fares for the following ferry services:

- ▼ Newcastle (Stockton) ferry
- ▼ Central Coast Ferries (Woy Woy – Empire Bay)
- ▼ Church Point Ferries (Church Point – Scotland Island)
- ▼ Dangar Island Ferry (Brooklyn – Dangar Island)
- ▼ Clarence River Ferries (Illuka – Yamba)
- ▼ Cronulla and National Park Ferry (Cronulla – Bundeena)
- ▼ Palm Beach Ferries (Palm Beach – the Basin – Mackerel & Palm Beach – Wagstaff – Ettalong)
- ▼ Matilda Cruises (Circular Quay – Darling Harbour & Circular Quay – Lane Cove).

IPART has released an information paper for this review that sets out the review process and timing, preliminary indications of changes in costs and likely fare increases to take effect from late 2009 or early 2010.
