

Review of maximum prices charged for water management from 2010/11

Invitation for submissions

The Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART) is conducting a review under Section 11(1) of the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal Act 1992 to determine maximum prices that can be charged by the Water Administration Ministerial Corporation (WAMC) for water management activities from 1 July 2010. The NSW Department of Water and Energy (DWE) undertakes the majority of the WAMC's water management activities.

IPART has released an Issues Paper to provide relevant background information and key issues to assist DWE and other interested parties in making submissions. A submission by DWE is due by 11 September 2009 and will be made public on IPART's website (www.ipart.nsw.gov.au).

Interested members of the public and stakeholder organisations will have the opportunity to review DWE's submission and make submissions by 23 October 2009. Unless a specific request is made for confidentiality, submissions will be made available to the public. Any claims for confidentiality should be clearly displayed on the front of the submission.
