Review of prices for Hunter Water from 1 July 2016

Invitation for submissions

The Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART) is conducting a review of the prices that Hunter Water can charge its customers for water, sewerage and stormwater drainage services.

Hunter Water's current determination was due to conclude on 30 June 2017. However, at Hunter Water's request IPART has brought forward the timing and commenced a review for new prices to apply from 1 July 2016.

IPART has released its Issues Paper on this review, which provides relevant background information and identifies key issues. This follows the receipt of Hunter Water's pricing proposal, which is available on the IPART website (www.ipart.nsw.gov.au).

Interested parties will have the opportunity to provide submissions to IPART's Issues Paper, as well as Hunter Water's pricing proposal, by no later than 5 October 2015. Information regarding the process of lodging submissions is available on the IPART website.
