

Review of prices for land valuation services

Invitation for Submissions and Public Hearing

The Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART) is conducting a review of prices for the land valuation services provided by the Valuer-General to councils from 1 July 2014.

IPART has released an Issues Paper which provides relevant background information and identifies key issues to assist the Valuer-General and other interested parties in making submissions. The Valuer-General's submission is due on 31 January 2014 and will be made public on the IPART website (www.ipart.nsw.gov.au).

Interested parties will have the opportunity to provide submissions to our review of the Valuer-General's prices, by no later than 7 February 2014. Information regarding the process of lodging submissions is available on the IPART website.
